The center is located approximately 1/4 mile south/east of I-30 at the intersection of Mabelvale West Road and Otter Creek East Boulevard.

When traveling west on I-30, take **exit 128**: Otter Creek Road/Mabelvale West; when traveling east on I-30, take **exit 126**: Alexander Road/Alexander and follow the access road to Mabelvale West Road.
