***On-Site Clinic*** - Students have access to the Baptist Health On-Site Clinic. The clinic is staffed by an Advanced Practice Nurse and provides treatment for common minor illnesses. There is no appointment necessary; patients are seen on a first come first serve basis. Students pay a Health Fee each semester, and there is a \$25 copay due at the time of service. The clinic is located in the Doctor's Park Building. 9600 Baptist Health Drive, Suite 260. 501-312-8844. Hours of operation: Monday - Friday 8 am - 5 pm. Closed 12 -1 pm for lunch.

***Assistance with Home Emergency*** - house fire, car accident, etc - to obtain needed supplies for school classes, etc. The Academic & Spiritual Counselor, Dr. P. Hope Coleman, can be reached at 202-7721 during business hours.

***Prescription Assistance*** - Assistance is offered for short-term payment of prescription medications. In addition Walmart and other pharmacies offer generic prescriptions for \$4. Contact Chaplain P. Hope Coleman at 202-7721 during business hours.

***Emotional Health Assistance*** - The Baptist Health Behavioral Services Clinic is available to students and is located on the Southwest Campus. You may call 501.487.6010 for an appointment. For more information check out Counseling Services on the BHCLR website.

***Counseling Services for Sexual Abuse*** - Safe Places is a counseling center that specializes in assisting women who have been the victim of sexual abuse at some time during their lives. It is located at 1609 Broadway in Little Rock. Call for an appointment at 501.374.7233.

***Food Assistance*** - Rock Creek Care Center Food Bank is located at The Church at Rock Creek on 36<sup>th</sup> Street in Little Rock.
