Baptist Health College Little Rock is accredited by the Accrediting Board of Health Education Services (ABHES) and has signed the Department of Defense Memorandum of Understanding (DoD MOU).

The Federal Tuition Assistance (TA) and the National Guard Tuition Assistance Program (NGTA) programs are separate from the Veteran's Assistance (VA) program. The TA programs are administered through the Baptist Health College Little Rock's (BHCLR) Business Office and the NGTA and VA programs are handled through BHCLR's Financial Aid Office.

You must apply to each program individually in order to be eligible. Additionally, **TA must be approved prior to the course start date.**

All TA funds will be applied to your student financial account prior to the application of any Pell Grant funds.

Arkansas National Guard Tuition Assistance Program (NGTA)

- Formerly known as the Arkansas National Guard Tuition Incentive Program (GTIP).
- NGTA is a state funded program which provides a tuition free benefit to qualifying members of the Arkansas Army and Air National Guards.
